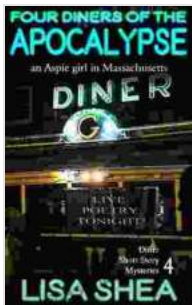


Four Diners of the Apocalypse: An Aspie Girl in Massachusetts Diner Short Story

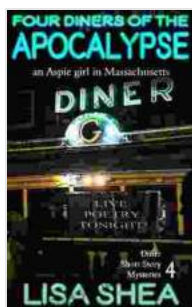
